- It's beyond our belief when we see Sofiya Shaikh sitting and chatting to her daughter on phone in front of us. It's so because AAWC staff saved her life by hospitalizing her timely into Seweree TB hospital as Doctors have almost given up hope for her survival.

Later on in interaction with women, lots of sensitive child issues were brought up for their better understanding as a mother to deal with. 26 women attended the program and were very responsive.
- We held a meeting at our Kamathipura centre with women to give orientation of AAWC activities in relation with better understanding of their Basic human rights. Also briefed about rules and regulations of Day care centre.
